

# ALBERTA 5 PIN BOWLERS ASSOCIATION YOUTH CHALLENGE PROVINCIAL & NATIONALS COACH & MANAGER CRITERIA



## **Provincial Coaching Criteria**

- Prior to the event the coach must be
  - o a 5 Pin Bowling Competitive Coach Certified,
  - o be a minimum nineteen (19) years of age as of December 31 of the current season,
  - o be a current A5PBA member in good standing
  - o with a valid Police Record Check (PRC) filed at the A5PBA office.
  - Coach at the current Provincial event

### **National Coaching Criteria**

- The province will select one female and one male coach for the National Championship
- Those wishing to be considered for nationals must submit a resume and/or their name prior to the start of the Provincial event
- A provincial selection committee consisting of a minimum of 3 (three) A5 Board Members in attendance at the Provincial event for the entire time will observe the coaches and...

### The coach will be evaluated on,

- Qualifications and accuracy of the Resumé
- Adherence to the Dress Code as and when required for bowlers and coaches
- Attitude of bowlers towards the coach.
- Attitude of people in general towards the coach
- Coach's Attitude --- Positive or Negative
  - Towards team
  - Towards other coaches
  - Towards officials and tournament committee
  - Towards other teams
- Communication Skills
  - Provides accurate information

- Management of Team
  - At and during the tournament
  - o At the hotel
  - During the dance and other functions
  - Conduct
  - During free time
- Sportsmanship
  - o Abide by rules and formats as laid out in Coach's Manual and A5PBA Format
- Organization of the Team
  - Have team ready as required (re: tournament, pictures, transportation, functions, etc.)

### **Manager Qualifications**

- Each Zone shall designate a "Manager" for the contingent who cannot be a bowler or a coach.
- Due to the responsibilities associated with these position, coaches and managers must
  - o Be a minimum 19 (nineteen) years of age as of December 31 of the current season
  - o Be a current A5PBA member in good standing.
  - Have a current Police Record Check (PRC) filed at the A5PBA office including the vulnerable sector. A PRC is valid for 5 (five) years.
  - Have completed Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders a minimum of 2 (two) weeks prior to the Provincials
