

ALBERTA 5 PIN BOWLERS' ASSOCIATION

OPEN PROVINCIALS PERFECT GAME COMPETITION – Policy

PREAMBLE

To reward a bowler that bowls a perfect game at the Alberta Open Provincial Tournament, a Perfect Game Competition has been instituted. Funded by participating bowlers, the Perfect Game Competition is operated annually by the Open Provincial host committee and carryover funds are maintained by the Alberta 5 Pin Bowlers' Association (A5PBA). The following guidelines document how the Perfect Game Competition will be administered.

GUIDELINES

- Perfect Game Competition entry.
 - The Open Provincial host committee will provide each zone manager an envelope containing one form per team that will be used to record the bowlers participating in the current year Perfect Game Competition.
 - The cost per entry is \$20 per bowler and participation is voluntary. To be eligible for the prize money, the winning bowler(s) must have entered the Perfect Game Competition prior to bowling.
 - The entry forms and fees must be forwarded to the Open Provincial host committee at the Coaches/Managers meeting.
 - 100% of the entry fees are submitted to the A5PBA office by the Open Provincial host committee.
- Awarding of prizes.
 - The bowler or bowlers, in the event of more than one, who have entered the Perfect Game Competition, that bowl a perfect game during the duration of the Alberta Open Provincial Tournament, including singles and team events, will receive an equal share of the Perfect Game Competition fund which is comprised of any money carried over from the prior year plus money contributed to the current year.
 - If an eligible perfect game is not thrown, the bowler or bowlers, in the event of more than one, who have entered the Perfect Game Competition, that throw the highest game during the Tournament will receive an equal share of 10% of the total money contributed to the current year.
 - The A5PBA will issue cheques to the winning bowler(s) shortly after Alberta Open Provincials Tournament.
- Fund carryover.
 - The Perfect Game Competition fund will be managed by the A5PBA in a dedicated bank account separate from the general funds of the Association.
 - Any interest earned on the perfect game bank account will be transferred to the A5PBA general funds on an annual basis.
 - The amount in the fund, less any interest earned, will carry forward to the subsequent years' Perfect Game Competition prize money.
