RECORD SCORE CRITERIA

C5PRA #

Five pin bowling scores bowled within the Province of Alberta must meet the following criteria in order to be recognized as an official record score by the Alberta 5 Pin Bowlers' Association (A5PBA).

- 1. The bowler achieving the score must be a member in good standing of the A5PBA, i.e., must have a membership card prior to bowling the record scored.
- 2. Scores must be bowled in a member centre of Bowl Alberta in:
 - a. Regular league play (winter, spring, short leagues, etc.) governed under the rules of the Canadian 5 Pin Bowlers' Association (C5PBA), i.e. no novelty formats, 2 frames at a time, etc.
 - b. All qualifying rounds and levels of C5PBA tournaments.
 - c. Tournaments sanctioned by A5PBA.
 - d. Scores must be bowled on lanes that are certified.
- 3. The A5PBA will
 - a. Recognize all record scores submitted to the Association in a manner determined by the Board of Directors.
 - b. Will keep an archive of Provincial Record Scores at Bowling Headquarters.
 - c. Will submit changes and additions to Provincial Record Scores to C5PBA.
